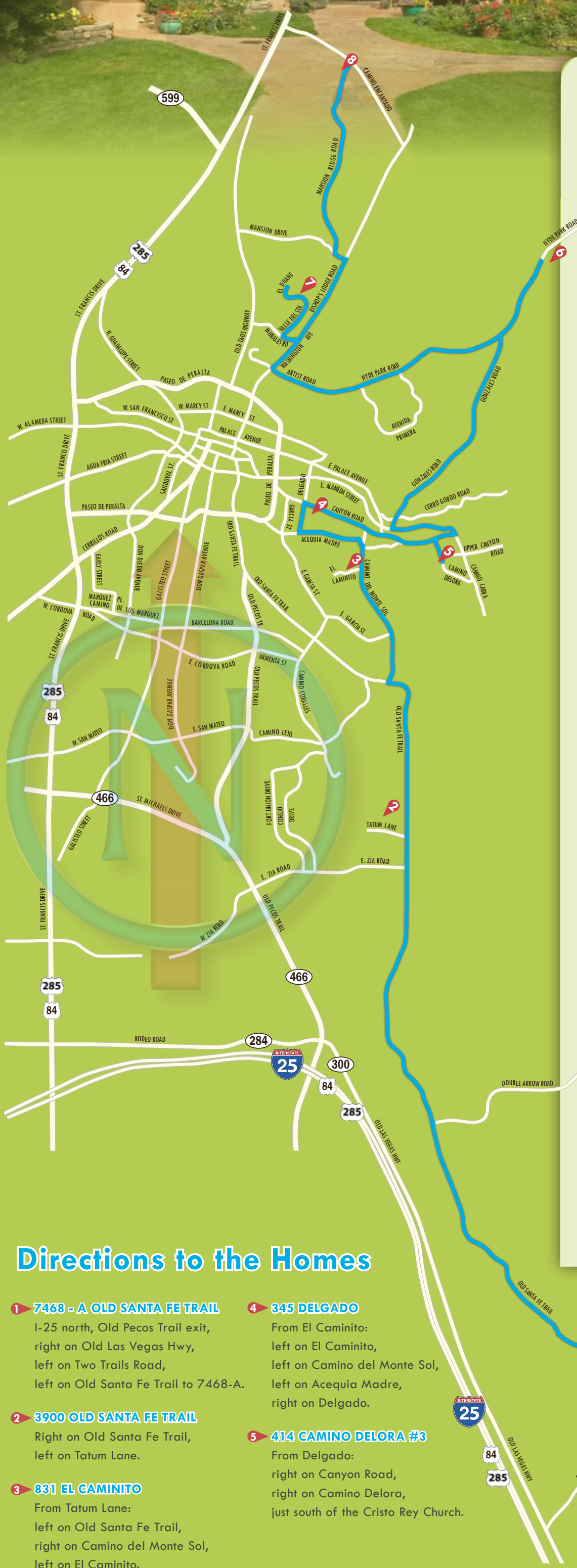
### 1104 MANSION RIDGE ROAD

#### 1 7468 - A OLD SANTA FE TRAIL

I-25 north, Old Pecos Trail exit, right on Old Las Vegas Hwy, left on Two Trails Road, left on Old Santa Fe Trail to 7468-A.

#### 2 3900 OLD SANTA FE TRAIL

Right on Old Santa Fe Trail, left on Tatum Lane.

#### 3 831 EL CAMINITO

From Tatum Lane: left on Old Santa Fe Trail, right on Camino del Monte Sol, left on El Caminito.

#### 4 345 DELGADO

From El Caminito: left on El Caminito, left on Camino del Monte Sol, left on Acequia Madre, right on Delgado.

#### 5 414 CAMINO DELORA #3

From Delgado: right on Canyon Road, right on Camino Delora, just south of the Cristo Rey Church.

#### 6 1430 HYDE PARK ROAD

From Camino Delora: right on Canyon Road, left on Alameda, right on Gonzales Road, right on Hyde Park Road, right on Cañada del Sur (through gate into the subdivision), right on Cañada Ancha.

#### 7 263 EL DUANE COURT

From Hyde Park Road: left on Hyde Park Road, right on Washington, left on Murales Road, right on Valle del Sol, right on El Duane Court.

#### 8 1104 MANSION RIDGE

From El Duane Court: right on Valle del Sol, left on Murales Road, left on Bishop's Lodge Road, left on Mansion Drive, right on Mansion Ridge Road.
